Jons Civil Engineering is committed to maintaining a working environment that is safe, healthy, and attentive to the environment and in compliance with all applicable European, national and local regulations.

We are committed to performing all of our activities, operations and other services in a manner that eliminates or minimises any adverse impacts on the environment, or the safety and health of our employee's visitors, sub contractors and suppliers in so far as reasonably practicable. We are committed to continual improvement of environmental performance and reduction of occupational injury and illness and we encourage environmental, health and safety responsibility.

We actively support this policy by setting objectives and targets, and implementing an EHS Management Programme on our site. Specifically, it is our policy to:

- provide and maintain a safe environment for our employees, for visitors to our site, and for contractors working on our site and ensure that all comply with this policy
- to ensure the provision of - safe plant and equipment, safe systems of work, systems for consultation, safety training, supervision, appropriate welfare facilities and personal protection equipment
- Keep up to date with relevant Health & Safety Acts, Regulations and codes of practice.
- minimise work place accidents, incidents and near misses. Eliminate risk where practicable and reduce residual risks to as low as reasonably practicable by the risk assessing of work place hazards.
- maintain a high level of preparedness to deal with emergencies
- replace hazardous substances with less hazardous substances where practicable.
- keep up to date with the relevant environmental legal requirements and emission standards and comply with them;
- prevent and reduce the amount of waste generated on site, reuse material on-site where feasible, or salvage for subsequent reuse to the greatest extent possible, consider disposal as a last resort, keep in place objectives, targets and guidance for waste management,
- minimise emissions to air, sewer and noise emissions.
- optimise electricity, gas and water usage.
- minimise the frequency of environmental incidents and to minimise the environmental impact of any such incidents.
- maintain a high level of communication with all interested parties (employees, contractors, regulatory authorities, public) in regard to our environmental health & safety requirements and environmental performance.

We are committed to the continual education and training of our employees to enable the implementation of this Environmental, Health and Safety Policy. Jons Civil Engineering will undertake to review and revise, where necessary, this Policy to take note of any change in legislation or work practices.
